Anticipation Guide Strategy

An anticipation guide is a comprehension strategy that is used before reading to activate students' prior knowledge and build curiosity about a new topic. Before reading, students listen to or read several statements about key concepts presented in the text; they're often structured as a series of statements with which the students can choose to agree or disagree.

Using Anticipation Guides as a Pre-Reading Strategy~How It's Done With your document complete, now it's time to distribute a copy to each student. After carefully reviewing the instructions with the class (if this is the first time they've done an anticipation guide), read the statements to them, with them, or have them read individually.

Quick Tip - Anticipation/Reaction Guide

When using any teaching strategy, teachers should (1) help students to understand why a strategy is useful, and (2) describe explicitly how the strategy should be used. Teacher demonstration, modeling, and follow-up independent practice are critical factors for success. Student discussion following strategy instruction is also helpful.

Though an anticipation guide works well as pre- and post-reading activity, it can be applied to any learning experience. Use with video or film presentations, guest speakers, or field trips to help focus students' attention on key learning goals.

Anticipation/Predication Guides Anticipation/Predication Guides Purpose of teaching Anticipation Guides: Anticipation Guides (Herber, 1978) are typically a list of statements related to a topic that act as scaffolding for student understanding of the text. Students indicate if they agree or disagree with each of the statements.

Completing anticipation guides helps students recognize and connect to themes that surface in their learning. Use this strategy at the beginning of a unit or before engaging with a text.

Anticipation Guide - Comprehension Strategies

An Anticipation/Reaction Guide utilizes a twin strategy to increase reading comprehension: stimulate prior knowledge and experiences before reading and then reinforce key concepts after reading. The guide presents students with a series of leading questions to be answered in writing before reading.
