This service, as the “Caeremoniale episcoporum” expressly directs, is to be anticipated and it should be sung shortly after Compline “about the twenty-first hour”, i.e. about three p. m. on the eve of the day to which it belongs.

Tenebrae (/ˈtɛ.nə.breɪ/ or /ˈtɛ.nə.bri/—Latin for "darkness") was a religious service of Western Christianity consisting of matins and lauds of the last three days of Holy Week (Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday) celebrated on the evening of the previous day to the accompaniment of the gradual extinguishing of candles.

During the Sacred Triduum (Holy Thurs, Good Fri. and Holy Sat.), the Matins and Lauds of the Divine Office are often sung in a haunting service known as the Tenebrae service ("tenebrae" meaning "shadows"), which is basically a funeral service for Our Lord.

The Tenebrae service is usually done in Early morning, formerly also at night or Midnight. It consists of Readings from Scriptures (usually 7, 8, or 15, and even in some churches in ancient times, as many as 12, 24 or 72!).

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
