To drive smoothly with a manual transmission, start by moving the gearstick in between third and fourth gear to put the car into neutral. Next, push your foot all the way down on the clutch, start the car, and push the gearstick into first gear.

As a beginning driver, you will want to know that usually, a stick shift has four or five forward gears and reverse. There is also a clutch pedal to the left of the brake pedal. In order to change gears, you must first press the clutch down and then shift the manual transmission into first gear.

Slow the car for a corner by depressing the clutch and shifting the manual transmission into a lower gear. Blip the throttle to get the RPMs up and release the clutch. Put pressure on the brake to bring the car to the speed required for the corner. Return to the higher gear once the road straightens out to accelerate.

Driving a car with a manual transmission—also called a stick shift—requires more skill and understanding than operating a vehicle with an automatic transmission. In a stick shift vehicle, you will be manually shifting gears to adjust your speed, rather than letting the car do it for you.

If your vehicle has automatic transmission, it knows when to shift. Every time you accelerate to pass another vehicle, go uphill or downhill, the appropriate gear kicks in. This is fully automatic and many drivers never give it a second thought. You can, however, still have some control over when your transmission shifts.

Because automatic transmission changes the gear ratios depending upon the motion so that you as a driver stay, free from shifting the gears each time. Whenever you release the gas pedal and step on the brake while driving downhill, the active engine neither burns the fuel nor generates the heat consequently; an automatic transmission isn't exhausted at all.
