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**Tenant Rights in California—Real Estate Law**  
Tenants or renters in California have certain rights and responsibilities determined by state laws. This applies to most housing situations where the tenant is renting from a landlord, but there are some exceptions.

Tenant Rights to Withhold Rent in California Tenants may withhold rent, move out without notice, sue the landlord, call state or local health inspectors, or exercise the right to "repair and deduct" if a landlord fails to take care of important repairs, such as a broken heater.

In California, you are required to create and sign a written rental agreement for any rental period that exceeds 12 months according to landlord tenant law California specifications.

**California Tenant Rights to Withhold Rent or "Repair and ...**  
Tenant Rights in California Evictions Landlords in California have the right to evict a tenant who has failed to live up to his or her end of the contractual agreement. To do so, the landlord must file with the court, and the court then presents eviction documents to the tenant, who then has five days to respond to the eviction papers.

**California Tenants' Rights — California Renters' Legal ...**  
Payment Methods: Landlord must allow the tenant to pay rent using a form of payment that is not a cash payment or an electronic funds transfer payment. If the tenant had an insufficient funds payment or a stopped payment on a money order, the landlord can then require that rent be paid in cash.

**California Rental Laws**  
Tenants are sometimes the beneficiaries of this arrangement. The failure to register a rent-controlled unit prohibits the landlord from asking for rent or suing to evict the tenant. Some landlords operate under a "fictitious business name" such as "California Apartments", identified as such on the rental agreement and rent checks you pay.
