The Pyramid of Khufu (or the Pyramid of Cheops) is the oldest and the largest among the three pyramids. It initially stood at 481 feet and was the tallest man-made structure for about 3,800 years. Now, due to factors like erosion and other natural causes, it stands at 455 feet with a base of 754 feet (230 meters) and is comprised of over two million blocks of stone.
