These include basic resources such as food and water, as well as biological conditions, such as maintaining a certain range of temperature and pH levels.

Fundamental human needs. Human needs can be understood as a system—i.e., they are interrelated and interactive. In this system, there is no hierarchy of needs (apart from the basic need for subsistence or survival) as postulated by Western psychologists such as Maslow, rather, simultaneity, complementarity and trade-offs are features of the process of needs satisfaction.
