Total depravity applied: The doctrine of total depravity is at the very heart of the gospel, and thus the applications are many. But I must limit myself to four: 1. The doctrine of total depravity should cause me to despair completely of myself, my ability, my merit, and my will, and to cast myself completely upon Christ alone for salvation.

"Total Depravity is probably the most misunderstood tenet of Calvinism. When Calvinists speak of humans as "totally depraved," they are making an extensive, rather than an intensive statement.
